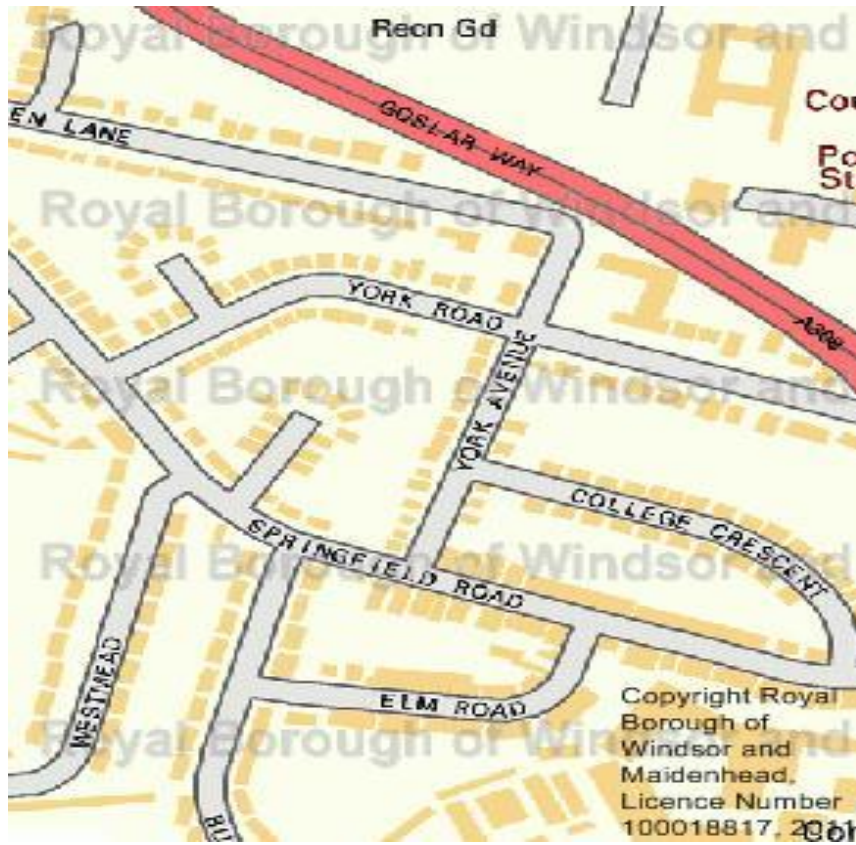


Parking Review Phase VI

Springfield Road Area, Windsor

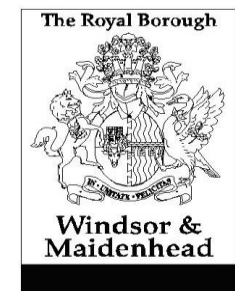
Consultation Document 10 November 2011



On the 14th January 2008, the department for Transport delegated parking enforcement from the Thames Valley Police into the hands of the Royal Borough of Windsor & Maidenhead Council. Since that time we have made a number of changes but are looking to make further increases in the total number of spaces available to local residents.

At present, we are carrying out a review of parking regulations in your area, and want to hear your views. Please take a few moments to complete and return this questionnaire.

Dear Resident,

Following a review of parking in your area, the Council are looking to consult with Residents regarding any future possible changes.

Would you like to make your road "Residents Only" between the times of 11:00 – 13:00 **YES / NO**

If the majority said yes to this proposal Residents would be entitled to apply for a maximum of 2 Residents Permits per household, reduced by any off-street parking spaces they have. Permits currently cost £20 and £40 annually for the first permit and second permit respectively. All Households would be entitled to apply for 125 Visitor Vouchers (2Hr/6Hr/24HR) per financial year.

Note the roads being consulted for residents parking schemes are: Springfield Road East (from Alma Rd to junction of Westmead), Elm Road , College Crescent, York Road & Green Lane. Schemes will be implemented on a road by road basis meaning roads surrounding yours may have a resident only scheme whilst your road does not, and vice versa.

A number of new signs / posts will be needed for implementation – are you willing for a sign to be placed on your wall/fence? **YES / NO**
