## Children's Centre at South Ascot Village School

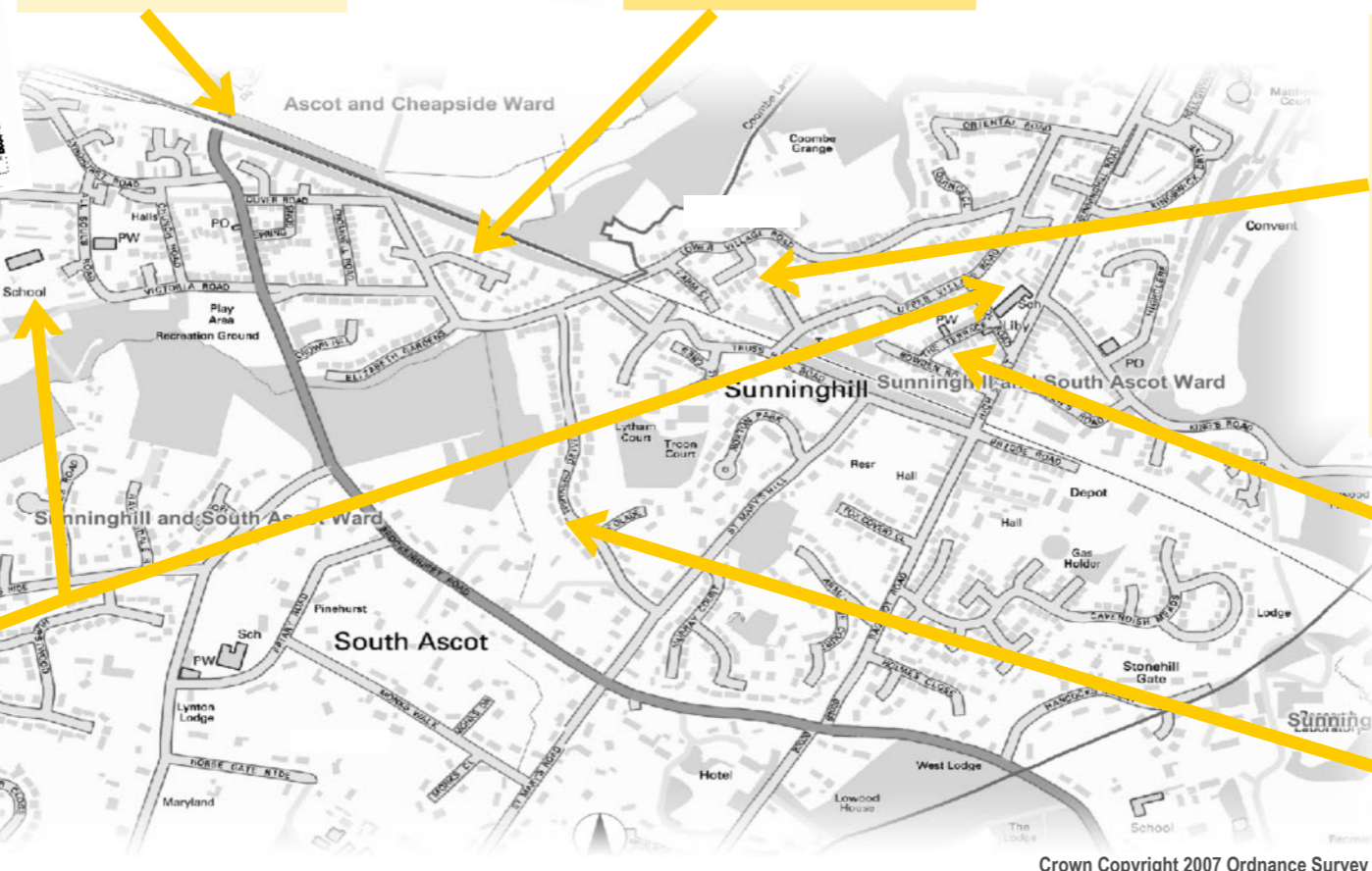
In the longer term Lib Dems plan to create a "Children's Centre" at South Ascot Village School

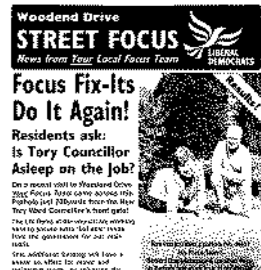
## Fixing Derelict Houses in Exchange Rd

Jonathan is extremely concerned about over-development in the area.

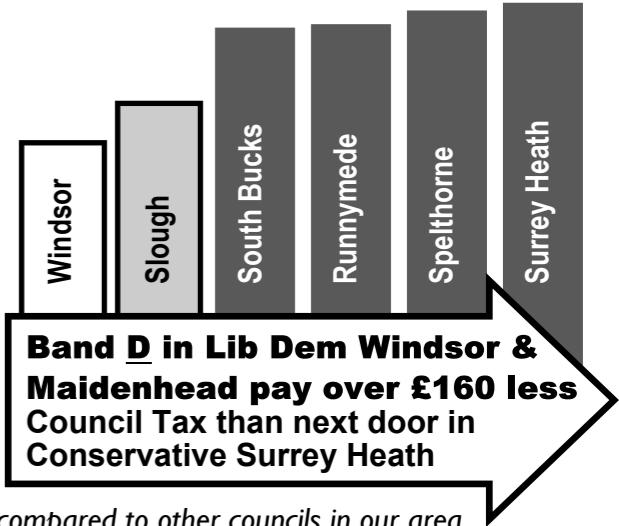
