Residents Contact Lib Dems for Action

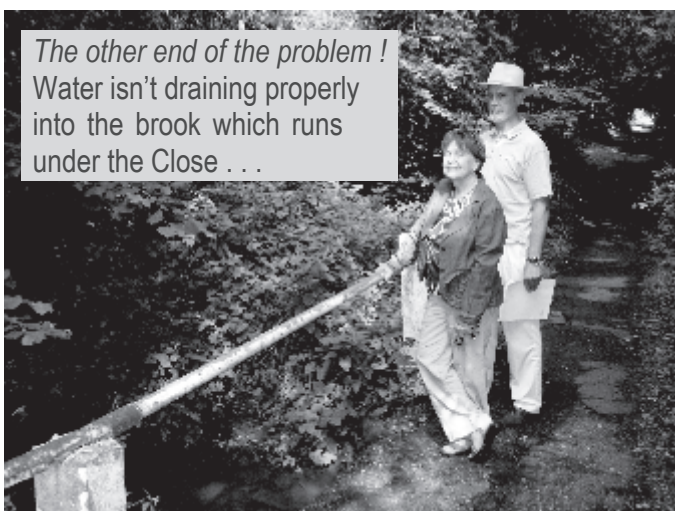
Following the Action on Roads Article in our last FOCUS several people in the road contacted us about problems in Francis Chichester Close.
