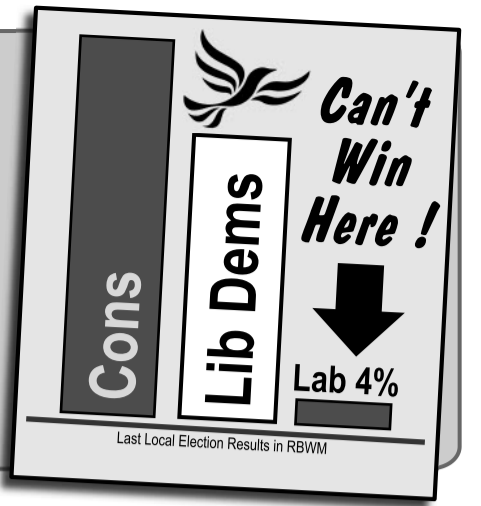
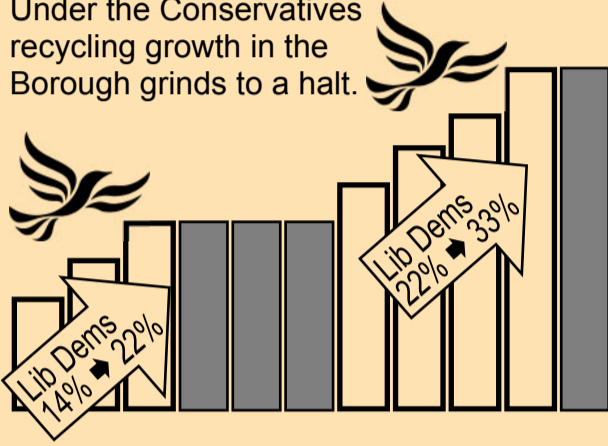

With the Lib Dems recycling goes up. Under the Conservatives recycling growth in the Borough grinds to a halt.

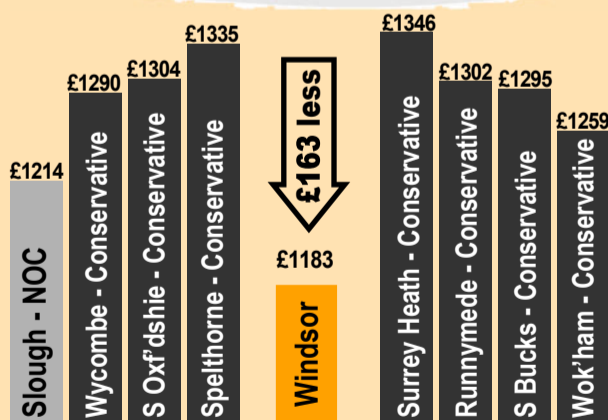

WANT WINDSOR PARK & RIDE BUILT

87% of residents in Windsor want the Park and Ride Scheme to go ahead. Sadly the scheme was cancelled by the Conservatives last November.

That's the findings so far of a Lib Dem Survey conducted across the town.

'Conservatives claim they decided to cancel Park & Ride because of views expressed at a meeting they held in Eton. The Lib Dems wanted to know what people in Windsor & Datchet wanted not just Eton. The Tories made their decision after their Eton Wick councillor threatened to quit if it went ahead, so it seems party unity is more important to the Tories than traffic in Windsor & Datchet.' says Lib Dem Leader Simon Werner.

The Survey shows that people in Windsor & Datchet want the Park & Ride built and that they think it should be between the Windsor relief road and the Windsor - Slough Railway as originally proposed.

The Park and Ride was funded by the South East of England Development Agency and millions of pounds of funding has now been lost thanks to the Conservatives. The location was chosen, as around the country Park & Ride sites near to motorways or other main routes have proved best at intercepting traffic flows into town centres.

"The Conservatives' multi-storey car park at Alexandra Gardens will make traffic problems in central Windsor and Datchet worse. It's outrageous the Conservatives threw away Windsor's £millions just to protect their own party unity."

Conservative dominated Thames Valley Police Authority has allowed Police Station opening hours in Windsor to be reduced. *The Royal Borough Observer* revealed that opening hours at the Police Station will be cut over the busy summer tourist season. Commenting in the Express Lib Dem Leader Simon Werner attacked the secret meetings now taking place: "This is a disgraceful abuse of power - The public have a right to know if their Greenbelt is at risk."

Conservative Council Leader David Burbage admitted the secret meetings had taken place and that the Conservatives were looking at developing on the Greenbelt, but claimed that the council had been ordered to do so by the Government.

Parliamentary proceedings recorded in Hansard show that the government deny this.

On 3rd July Government Minister, Iain Wright MP told the House of Commons that:

"No local planning authorities have been instructed to undertake green belt reviews."

In a separate move the Conservatives have eased the strict planning conditions imposed on the Medina Dairy following the Public Order problems two years ago. The changes allow the dairy to make far more noise before local people can ask the council to take action.

Tories say £29 Garden Stealth Tax will be Optional?

Garden waste collections were free with the old Lib Dem Council, but four months ago the Conservatives decided on plans for a £29 charge for Garden Waste Collection.

Then the Lib Dems' "Keep it Free" campaign started and confused Conservatives started postponing a final decision on the new charge.

Now the Conservatives say they will introduce a new fortnightly Garden Waste collection service charging £29, but keep the old free service as well! "I'm not really sure who the Tories think will pay £29, if the free service really does carry on." says local Lib Dem Julian Tisi.
