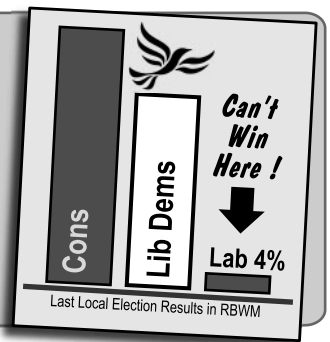
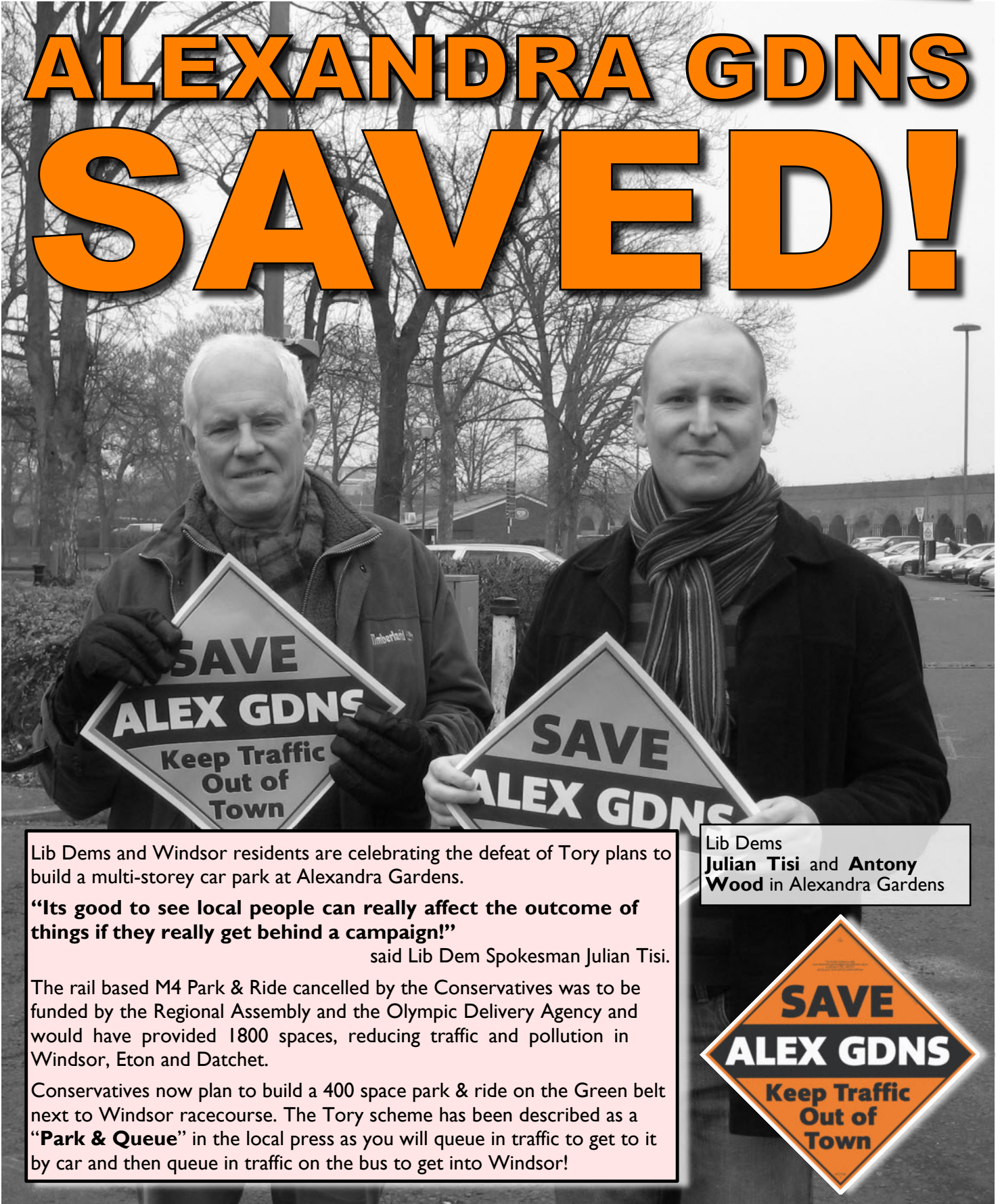


Castle Without FOCUS



ALEXANDRA GDNS SAVED!



Lib Dems and Windsor residents are celebrating the defeat of Tory plans to build a multi-storey car park at Alexandra Gardens.

"Its good to see local people can really affect the outcome of things if they really get behind a campaign!"

said Lib Dem Spokesman Julian Tisi.

The rail based M4 Park & Ride cancelled by the Conservatives was to be funded by the Regional Assembly and the Olympic Delivery Agency and would have provided 1800 spaces, reducing traffic and pollution in Windsor, Eton and Datchet.

Conservatives now plan to build a 400 space park & ride on the Green belt next to Windsor racecourse. The Tory scheme has been described as a **"Park & Queue"** in the local press as you will queue in traffic to get to it by car and then queue in traffic on the bus to get into Windsor!

£1 million more Tory Taxes

Borough Conservatives are having to raise fees and charges by £1 million to sort out the council's budget problems.

Essential home care services have risen by 18% in just over a year singling out the most vulnerable residents for one of the highest increases.

Some Examples

Home Care charges up to £15.50 an hour - 18% rise in just over a year

Children's swimming up by up to 10%

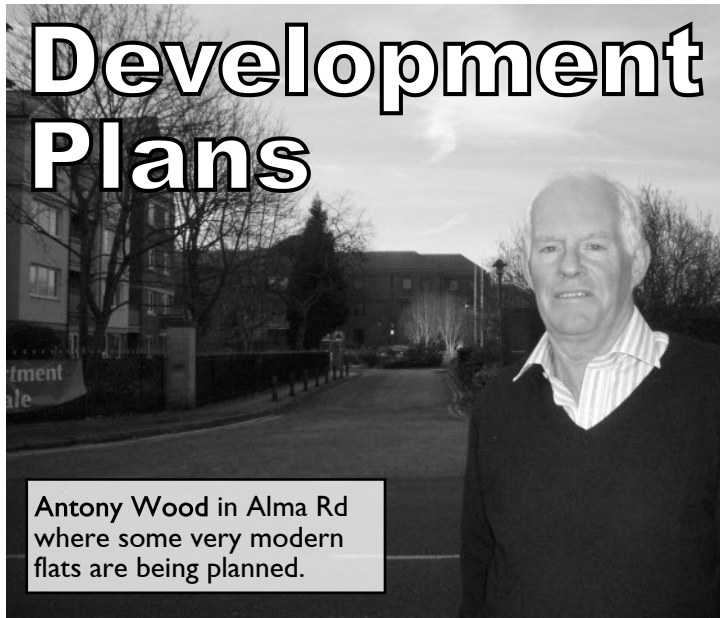
Collection of Bulk waste items up 23% in a year

Getting married up by 10% in some places

Increasing the cost for collection of bulky items will mean more fly tipping and at a time when we should be encouraging young people to get fit, there are some big increases for some junior swimming.

As we head into recession it seems ridiculous to be increasing the costs of Borough services for local residents.

The Tories should be tracking down savings, not covering up their budget disaster with sneaky stealth taxes.

Concerns are growing across Castle Without Ward about a number of new development plans.

In Clarence Road proposals to knock down an existing house and bungalow to build hostel accommodation for young people have just been abandoned, however it is not known what will happen to this building next. In a strange game of musical chairs, plans are afoot to demolish the YWCA (a hostel for young people) in King's Road to build houses!

In Alma Road plans are being developed to build very modern flats in steel and glass just outside the Windsor's conservation area.

"If this plan goes ahead it will be highly visible from parts of the historic Victorian and Edwardian street scene" says Local Lib Dem Antony Wood

Meanwhile local Conservatives have gone on the offensive against social housing, claiming Windsor doesn't need any more council or housing association homes despite a waiting list of over 2000.
